### Province Begins Consultations on the Proposed Practice of Medicine Regulation under the Regulated Health Professions Act (RPHA)

Physicians will be among the first healthcare professionals in Manitoba to move under the umbrella of the new [Regulated Health Professions Act](#) (RHPA). As a necessary first step, the Council of The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Manitoba (CPSM) consulted with Manitoba Health, Seniors and Active Living (MHSAL) to draft regulations which have now been approved by the CPSM Council. This proposed RHPA Practice of Medicine Regulation is now open for [public and stakeholder consultation](#) and MHSAL will be accepting comments and feedback until **April 3, 2018**.

At the same time, the CPSM has also opened several draft documents for public and stakeholder consultation, including

- The CPSM General Regulation (rules for performing reserved acts, applications for registration, classes of membership, education requirements, continuing competency and practitioner profiles);

## Health Canada Amendments - Antimicrobials in Veterinary Compounding

To promote prudent use of antimicrobials in food production, Health Canada has introduced amendments to the Food and Drug Regulations which will increase oversight of the importation and sales reporting of medically important antimicrobials active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) for veterinary use.

Pharmacists, veterinarians or those compounding a drug under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian must hold a drug establishment license (DEL) when importing medically important antimicrobials that are on [List A: List of Certain Antimicrobial Active Pharmaceutical Ingredients](#). Additionally, compounders and importers will be required to report annual sales of these antimicrobials including the total quantity sold or compounded.

Health Canada is offering webinars to provide more information on the new requirements affecting all health care practitioners who compound veterinary active pharmaceutical ingredients. If your pharmacy practice will be affected by these amendments, [Health Canada webinars](#) will be offered February 13 and 15, 2018.
