### Release of Model Standards for Non-Sterile Compounding

The National Association of Pharmacy Regulatory Authorities (NAPRA) has released the [Model Standards for Pharmacy Compounding of Non-Sterile Preparations](#) (Model Standards). The Model Standards have been released along with a [Guidance Document for Pharmacy Compounding of Non-Sterile Preparations](#) (Guidance Document) to aid with implementation.

College Council has tasked a working group consisting of pharmacists engaged in non-sterile compounding to review the document and provide recommendations to Council regarding an implementation plan and timeline. The College recommends that all pharmacies involved in compounding non-sterile products review the Model Standards and Guidance Document.

The College will provide more information on implementation of NAPRA Model Standards for Pharmacy Compounding of Non-Sterile Preparations in the coming months.

## Regulations Amending the Narcotic Control Regulations and the New Classes of Practitioners Regulations

The March 21st edition of the Canada Gazette, Part II: Volume 152, Number 6, outlined changes to the Narcotic Control Regulations and the New Classes of Practitioners Regulations (Diacetylmorphine (Heroin) and Methadone) that will come into effect May 19, 2018. Practitioners of medicine, nurse practitioners, dentists and veterinarians who want to prescribe methadone will no longer need to obtain a federal methadone exemption from the Office of Controlled Substances.

**Although methadone prescribers will no longer need a federal section 56 methadone exemption, provincial requirements and authorization for health care practitioners who want to prescribe methadone and buprenorphine-naloxone remain in place.**

As well, practitioners will still be required to meet all other applicable provisions of the *Narcotic Control Regulations*, as well as the requirements established by the provincial regulatory bodies when dealing with controlled substances.

Authorization to prescribe methadone and/or buprenorphine-naloxone for opioid replacement therapy (ORT) and/or pain must be obtained from the prescriber's provincial regulatory body. The College of Pharmacists of Manitoba and the College of Physicians and Surgeons are in the process of adapting their respective ORT guidelines and policies to reflect these changes.

The federal Regulation amendments will also allow practitioners of medicine and nurse practitioners to conduct activities with diacetylmorphine, either in or outside of a hospital setting. This was previously restricted to administration in hospital settings only.
