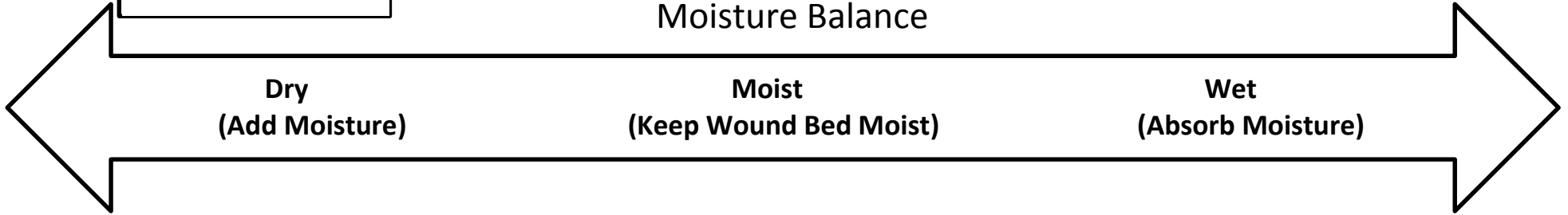


Quick Reference Guide for Wound Dressings

NO PERFUSION:
 ABPI: Less than 0.5
 TBPI: Less than 0.23 ± 0.19
 Pulses absent. Thin, shiny skin
 Dusky color toes/feet. Cool skin
 Back eschar caps to toes or heel
 Hair absent

Keep Dry (Paint with Povidone)

Moisture Balance
